

# **Annual Consolidated Report**

## **Uday Social Development Society**

### **2010-2011**

#### **Introduction**

Uday Society was registered in 2003 at Bhopal and it got registered under the MP Societies Registration Act for the integral development of the underprivileged sections of the society. Focusing on women, children and the youth Uday began its activities in few slums of Bhopal city. Later in 2010, the activities were expanded to different districts of Madhya Pradesh. At present it supports and facilitates activities through six units of four districts of Madhya Pradesh.

- 1) Slum Development Activities, Bhopal, Bhopal District
- 2) Indore Domestic Workers solidarity, Indore District
- 3) Community Development Work, Aulia, Khandwa District
- 4) Community Development Work, Sirpur, Khandwa District
- 5) Community Development Work, Dharampuri, Khandwa District
- 6) Community Development Work, Badi Dhamini, Jhabua District

The following are the activities undertaken through the head office

- Annual Planning & evaluations of the units
- Review visits and Planning once in 4 months and sending the reports to the units
- Account maintenance and financial management
- Brochures, flex and other printing IEC (Information, Education & Communication) materials were printed
- Continued updating of the office, reporting, documentation, translating from Hindi to English & English to Hindi etc.,
- AGM once a year and 3 times in a year Governing Body meeting
- Periodic correspondence & sending reports to PLT, CLT, VIVAT, CRI and sending news articles to Word India Magazine
- Attended meetings & Consultation of the parental organization (PASS)- such as National SSs JPIC Meeting, National VIVAT India International arranged by SVD, NGOs, Movements etc. and visits to govt. departments etc.

The major program of Uday are-

## **Women Development**

### *Activities*

- ❖ 56 Self Help Groups (SHG) are formed with bank accounts and women are motivated to be organized.
- ❖ Regular meetings of the groups takes place  
Through personal contacts domestic workers are organized, Legal awareness program and trainings are frequently conducted and arrange press conference and rally also were organized.  
42 domestic workers got their identity card as domestic workers
- ❖ 12 trainings for SHG members were organized and later Federation of SHG is formed with 10 SHG members
- ❖ 25 Vocational/skill development training and 17 awareness sessions on Social Legislation in the units were conducted so that people became aware of various social issues
- ❖ 9 Exposure visits were arranged for better performance and it has increased motivation in the work

### **Result found**

- ❖ Habit of saving is inculcated and it is improved in some groups
- ❖ The non-SHG members are motivated to take part in the activities organized by SHG members
- ❖ Girls were assisted to get sewing machine
- ❖ The girls prepared rakhi and got some earnings
- ❖ The tailoring students learned to stitch their own cloths
- ❖ The boys completed their technical education
- ❖ Seven members of 4 groups started self employment

## **Future Plan**

- ❖ More Women empowerment programs will be organized to improve the self confidence and to speak in public
- ❖ Organize women to take up right based issues
- ❖ Arrange training for maintaining record
- ❖ More number of SHGs are to be formed
- ❖ Explore Govt. support for girls for adolescent girls and plan for residential skill training program of 10 months

## **Development of children**

### ***Activities***

- ❖ Working with 4 Anganwadis/pre-primary school
- ❖ Remedial coaching to 107 children
- ❖ 47 children come in the Drop in Centre for child labor

### **Result**

The teachers are creatively teaching in the Anganwadis

Parents and children are encouraged and motivated for education

Children are disciplined & actively present in the class-room, Children performed better in their studies

13 Health education programs were conducted in schools. Children come to the school clean and healthy and more programs are planned for the next year

## **Community Based Programs**

- ❖ 26 Health camp awareness and 1,112 people benefitted either got treated or became aware of balanced diet, health and hygiene. It is planned to arrange health camp with the help of District TB Center. Future collaboration planned with NRHM (National Rural Health Mission) & Block Health Department
- ❖ 870 trees were planned for the Environment Protection. People maintain the trees planted in their campus and are taken care. Provide trees to all the SHG members and at the village level

## Other activities

- ❖ Observed important national and international days such International Women's Day, Global Hand Washing Day, Mother's Day, National festivals, etc.
- ❖ Networking other Govt. and NGOs- Women and child welfare department, NHDC (Narmada Hydro Development Corporation), Diocesan Social Service centers, Govt. Health Departments, Local Self Govt. like-Panchayath, Municipal Corporation, Other NGOs
- ❖ 48 persons with disabilities were identified for treatment care and rehabilitation besides, 13 of them were registered for pension from the Govt. department at Sirpur cluster
- ❖ Trained 3 Community Organizers with the support of CDH Bhopal and XIDAS Jabalpur
- ❖ Literacy Program for 30 women at Badi Dhamini
- ❖ Summer camp for children was arranged and 73 of them benefited at Bhopal for children from the slum
- ❖ De-addiction program was conducted and 19 persons attended the session
- ❖ 5 meetings were held to organize the domestic workers for their rights and 10. Various survey is being conducted for the purpose of the units and project proposals
- ❖ 5 Training were arranged for the staff

Various activities are conducted in four districts of Madhya Pradesh. Activities like skill development program, formation of SHG and federation, community based programs such as tree plantation, health camps etc are organized. The details of SHG and skill development are given in the annexure.
